





Genesis 3:14-15



¹⁴And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.





(At this time, the pastor takes the light from the Christ candle to the assistants. They pass the light on to the congregation. Tip only the unlighted candle.)

Pastor: As the light of these candles illumine our faces, it reminds us of Christ,

our Light, the child in the manger at Bethlehem, a Savior suffering our death on the cross, and soon to come from His throne on high as Judge of all. He is our Light here on earth and the eternal Light who enlightens heaven, where there is no need of candle or sun. Rejoice! The Light of the World has come. That light transforms us with the brightness of His glory. This is the message we have heard from Him and proclaimed to

you: that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.

People: If we say we have fellowship with Him but still walk in darkness, we

lie, and do not live according to the truth.

Pastor: But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with

one another;

People: And the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all our sins.

Pastor: You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden.

Neither do people light a lamp and then cover its light. Instead they set the lamp on its stand, set up high, and it lights everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before everyone, that they may see

your good works and give praise to your Father in heaven.

People: Amen.
