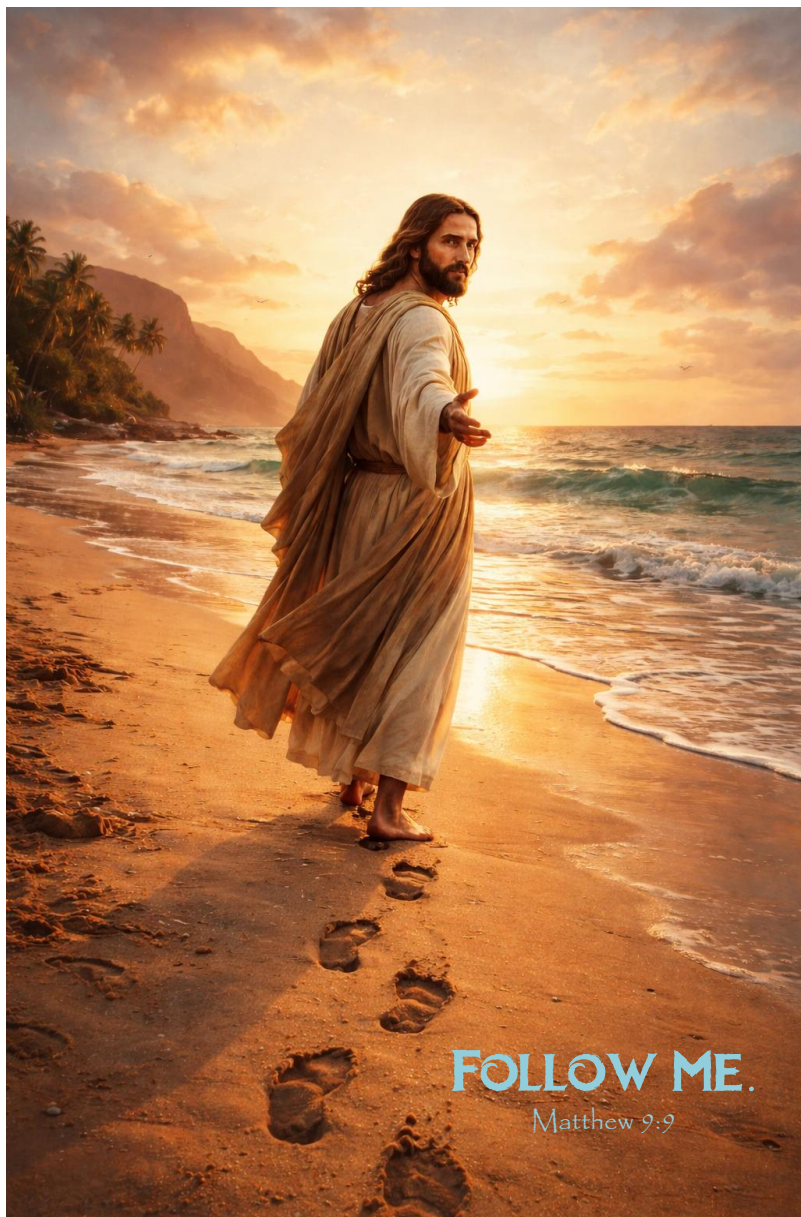

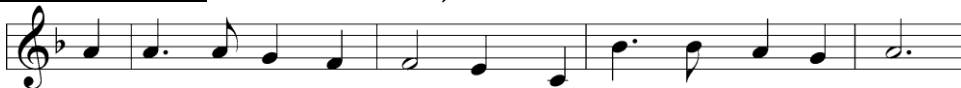



## CONFESSION OF THE LUTHERAN FAITH

*The Augsburg Confession. Article XX.*


